

Response to Intervention at BK in 2019

Implement a schedule change for the 2019/2020 school year to add an intervention period twice a week (Tuesday / Thursday). This period would allow for intervention and enrichment opportunities for students.

What is RTI?

Response to Intervention

RTI is the practice of providing high-quality instruction for all students and focused interventions as needed based on data indicating students' levels of performance.

Why RTI?

- We seem to be doing all of the right things, yet our students are still behind.
- The Learning Center has been successful for both ELA and Math -
 - RTI would allow EVERY subject the chance to have interventions (additional help)
 - Students would stop missing PE/Electives
- Students that need additional help will get it in timely fashion and they won't have to wait until they fall even more behind or go after school for tutoring
- Students that understand the material in class can go further enriching their passion for any subject -there is something for everyone

What does this look like?

- 25 minute intervention period called "SHARK Time"
- Tuesdays and Thursdays
- We will have a different bell schedule for SHARK Time AND Planning Days (please see bell schedule)
- Student will either be assigned or can choose where to go
- Intervention or enrichment will be their choices (unless it is requested by a teacher)
